Received in exchange for 460 shares of Unocal Corporation common stock in connection with the merger of Unocal Corporation and a wholly-owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation (the "Merger") pursuant to the Agreement and Plan of Merger dated as of April 4, 2005 among Unocal, Chevron and a wholly-owned subsidiary of Chevron, as amended by Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement and Plan of Merger dated as of July 19, 2005 ("Merger Agreement"). On the effective date of the Merger, the closing price of Unocal Corporation's common stock was \$66.10 per share, and the closing price of Chevron Corporation's common stock was \$62.48 per share.

2. This number includes the acquisition of 115 shares of Chevron Corporation common stock from the dividend equivalent accruals under the Chevron Non-Employee Directors' Equity Compensation and Deferral Plan.
